Matthew 27



JESUS ABANDONED BY MAN

- *“Then all the disciples deserted Him and fled.”* **Matthew 26:56**
- *“Do not be far from Me, for trouble is near and there is no one to help.”* **Psalm 22:11**

THE SEVERITY OF THE BEATING

- The severity of the beating is not detailed in the gospels; however, it is in the book of Isaiah. **Isaiah 50:6-8; 52:13-14**

SUFFERING ON THE CROSS—**Psalm 22:16-17; Isaiah 52-53**

- Jesus is led to the place of the skull—*Latin Calvary, Aramaic Golgotha*—to be crucified.





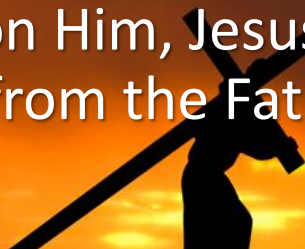
THE CRUCIFIXION

- The practice originated with the Persians, was later passed on to the Carthaginians and then Phoenicians, and finally to the Romans—who perfected this evil.

THE PHYSICAL SUFFERING OF THE CROSS **Psalm 22:14-15**

JESUS ABANDONED BY GOD

- *“About the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, ‘Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?’ that is, ‘My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?’”* **Matthew 27:46**
- With the sin of the world upon Him, Jesus suffered a spiritual death, a separation from the Father. **Isaiah 59:2**



DEATH BY CRUCIFIXION: SLOW, AGONIZING SUFFOCATION

- A LAST DRINK OF WINE VINEGAR **John 19:29-30**
- CELEBRATION BY THE OPPOSITION/SPIRITUAL WARFARE **Psalm 22:12-13**
- HIS LIFE GIVEN UP FOR US **Psalm 22:12-13; John 10:17-18; Luke 23:46**
- NOT A BONE BROKEN **John 19:32-33**
- DEATH IS CONFIRMED BY A SPEAR THRUST INTO THE RIGHT SIDE (THE HEART) **John 19:34**



JESUS' APPEARANCE IN HEAVEN

"Then I saw a Lamb, looking as if it had been slain, standing in the center of the throne, encircled by the four living creatures and the elders." **Revelation 5:6**

FOLLOWING JESUS CHRIST TODAY

"Then He said to them all: 'If anyone would come after Me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow Me.'"
Luke 9:23
