(Continuing our list) ***CARDIO THERAPY #5***

WE ENJOY THE FATHER'S LOVE v. 19-24

Jesus explained three expressions of ***God's love***:

- 1.** The past ministry of love to the disciples **v. 19-20**
- 2.** There is a present manifestation of His love to believers today. **v. 21, 23-24**
- 3.** There will be a future manifestation of love when Jesus returns. **v. 19; 2 Peter 3:1-10**

CARDIO THERAPY #6

YOU HAVE HIS GIFT OF PEACE v. 25-31

- *Shalom*—*peace*—means wholeness, completeness, health, security, even prosperity in the best sense.
- The world bases its peace on its **RESOURCES**, while God's peace depends on **RELATIONSHIPS**.
- Unbelievers walk by sight and depend on externals.
- Christians walk by faith and depend on the **ETERNALS** and **INTERNALS**.

THE HOLY SPIRIT USES THE WORD

- 1.** To give us God's peace **John 14:27**
- 2.** To give us God's love **John 15:9-10**
- 3.** To give us God's joy **John 15:11**

*If these things do not calm your troubled heart,
nothing will!*

In **John 14:30-31**, the Lord named two of our great spiritual enemies: the world and the devil.

JESUS HAS DEFEATED OUR ENEMY!

- Jesus overcame the world and the devil (**John 12:31**), so the devil has no claim on Him—or His disciples.
- Neither Satan nor the world can trouble our hearts if we are yielded to the “peace of God” through the Holy Spirit.
- Jesus was always the Master of the situation and He enables us to take control of our lives as we surrender to Him and receive His legacy of peace.

BLAZING STARS IN A DARK SKY

For the disciples, the storm clouds were gathering; the future was ominous.

They looked at the Lord and were astonished; *Jesus was oddly beginning to smile.*
