POWER IN HIS NAME

ACTS 3:1-4:4

A name, of course, implies much more than identification; it carries with it authority, reputation, and power.

- When somebody says, “You can use my name!” you sincerely hope the name is worth using.

The name of the Lord Jesus has all authority behind it, for He is God the Son. **MATT. 28:18**

THERE ARE THREE WONDERFUL TRUTHS ABOUT JESUS IN OUR PASSAGE TONIGHT.

1. HE IS AMAZING: JESUS, THE HEALER **ACTS 3:1-10**
2. HIS INDICTMENT: JESUS, GOD'S SON **ACTS 3:11-16**

In order to convince them of their crimes, Peter used several different names and titles for our Lord:

- **GOD'S SON—JESUS—THE HOLY ONE—THE JUST ONE—THE PRINCE** or Pioneer-originator of life
- This was no ordinary man that they had handed over to the Romans to crucify!

3. HE IS ENCOURAGEMENT: JESUS, THE SAVIOR!

ACTS 3:17-26 AND 4:1-4—Peter's second sermon

(Notice we cover a little bit of **ACTS 4:1-4**. *Remember, the chapter and verse designations are not inspired by the Holy Spirit—just the text!*)

- First, notice Peter did not leave the people without hope. He encouraged his people to trust Christ and experience His gracious salvation.

What did he tell them to do?

- First of all, they had to repent of their sins.
- Second, they had to be converted.

SEVEN KEYS FROM THIS PASSAGE:

1. God is long-suffering with lost sinners.
2. True witness involves the “bad news” of sin and guilt as well as the “good news” of salvation in Jesus Christ.
3. The way to reach the masses is by helping the individual.
4. The best defense of the truth of the Christian faith is a changed life.
5. Whenever God blesses, Satan shows up to oppose the work.
6. God has promised to bless and use His Word.
7. The name of Jesus Christ still has power!
