I. TWELVE MEN WITH AN INCONSISTENT WITNESS

ACTS 19:1-10

- This chapter is Paul's third missionary journey.
- Remember, doctrine that is correct leads to duty that is biblical.
- No, these twelve men had been baptized and were seeking to be religious, but something was missing—the real work and imprint of the Holy Spirit.

II. SEVEN MEN WITH INADEQUATE POWER

ACTS 19:11-20

When our Lord performed miracles, He usually had at least three purposes in mind:

1. To show His compassion as God and meet human needs.
2. To teach a spiritual truth in a tangible way.
3. To present His credentials as the Messiah.

III. A MOB OF INDIGNANT CITIZENS **ACTS 19:21-41**

Now the Silversmiths' riot breaks out!

- It was at this point that Satan attacked again, not as the **DECEIVER 2 COR. 11:3-4**
- but as the **DESTROYER 1 PETER 5:8**
- as well as the **MURDERER JOHN 8:44**
