PAUL BEFORE THE SANHEDRIN

ACTS 23

After defending himself, Paul decided to focus the Sanhedrin's attention on something even more controversial than himself: a theological debate concerning the ***RESURRECTION OF THE DEAD***.

Many things can be gleaned from this seemingly dead-end road of trying to reason with unreasonable people.

- 1.** No amount of human opposition can thwart God's plan and purposes.
- 2.** Address wrongs when you see them.

3. Always submit to the Word of God.
4. Use—don't lose—opportunities.
5. Look for long-term results.

ACTS 23:1-10 lists at least four ways to build a spiritual legacy that will last:

- a. Live wisely as a citizen of heaven.
- b. Address wrong when you see it.
- c. Submit to the Word when you hear it.
- d. Tell the Story when you get the opportunity.

THE PLAN TO KILL PAUL ACTS 23:12-22

- The promise of God's presence
- Lean on His tremendous promises.
- God is more than enough.

PAUL IS SENT TO CAESAREA ACTS 23:23-35

- Yikes, how dangerous was the Gospel!
- With God on his side, he could have walked unarmed and unescorted to Caesarea and arrived without a scratch.
- God works in unexpected ways.
